15 May Auckland / Guangzhou

Departure from Auckland airport for Guangzhou by CZ306(22:50-05:50+1).

16 May Guangzhou / Shanghai (No meal)

Arrive in Guangzhou to connect domestic flight to Shanghai. CTS guide will meet you in the airport and transfer to your hotel in Shanghai.

17 May Shanghai / Suzhou(B/L/D)

In the morning tour we will visit the Bund, a popular promenade along the Huangpu River, where the old meets the modern in Shanghai. You may see the local people performing Tai Chi during your stroll along the Bund. Continue to visit the Shanghai Museum. Shanghai Museum is a large museum of ancient Chinese art. The museum style and presentation surround visitors with artifacts demonstrating ancient wisdom and philosophy. Transfer to Suzhou-- a famous tourist city with the picturesque scenery. Have a boat trip on the Grand Canal and visit Shan Tang Street featured with Chinese traditional water town style.

18 May Suzhou/Wuxi (B/L/D)

Morning visit to Masters of Nets Garden. The great architectural achievement is the mood of tranquility and harmony that this humble garden embodies. Then continue to visit Silk Factory. Transfer to Wuxi in the afternoon. Visit Xihui Park and Jichang Garden. Later appreciate the Tea Pot Factory. Try foot massage tonight.

19 May Wuxi / Hangzhou (B/L/D)

Visit Turtle Head Park located at the side of Taihu Lake. Taihu Lake-- the third largest fresh water lake in China, is commonly believed to be the soul of the natural scenery and cultural relics in Wuxi. Continue to visit Pearl factory before coach to Hangzhou. After dinner, Own expense to enjoy the Night of West Lake show.

20 May Hangzhou/Wuzhen / Shanghai(B/L/D)

In the morning , take a cruise on the famous West Lake.

"Ripping water shimmering on sunny day,

Misty mountains shrouded the rain;

Plain or gaily decked out like Xizi;

West Lake is always alluring."

These are the words composed by the famous Song Dynasty poet Su Dongpo (960-1127) when he compared the West Lake to Xi Zi, the most beautiful woman in ancient China. These poetic sentiments leave one in no doubt of the glory of the scenery that inspired them. After that have a walk in Flower Harbor Viewing Fish Garden, then visit the tea plantation and enjoy the most famous green tea in China- Dragon Well Tea of course you may have the chance to purchase this good tea. Drive back to Shanghai via Wuzhen, one of the best preserved water towns in China.

21 May Shanghai (B)

Free at leisure to explore Shanghai at your own pace.

22 May Shanghai / Beijing (B/D)

Take fast train to Beijing. Upon arrival, transfer to enjoy a pedicab tour of Hutong -- the 'old city' neighbourhoods of narrow alleyways and courtyard gardens, experience local life on a family visit. After dinner, own expense to enjoy the Kongfu show(Chinese Martial Art).

23 May Beijing (B/L/D)

Morning tour to the Great Wall at Juyongguan section, stretching almost 4,000 miles from the Pacific Ocean to the sands of Central Asia and befittingly crowned one of the ten wonders of the world. Along the way, you will stopover at a jade carving factory where you can watch artisans at work. After lunch, continue to take an outside view of Bird's Nest and Water Cube, which are Olympic stadiums of 2008 Beijing Olympic Games. transfer to enjoy a pedicab tour of Hutong -- the 'old city' neighbourhoods of narrow alleyways and courtyard gardens, experience local life on a family visit.

24 May Beijing (B)

Morning tour to the Temple of Heaven, the 500 year old Temple houses altars on which sacrifices and offerings were laid to the gods in a glorious setting of gardens, trees and sculptures. Visit the Cloisonne Factory afterwards. Tour the Tian'anmen Square, the biggest public square in the world. You will also be able to have a photo stop at The National Centre for the Performing Arts, formerly known as the National Grand Theatre, and colloquially described as The Egg. Afterwards, we visit Forbidden City, the vast complex of palaces, which was home to successive Emperors for more than 500 years. Tonight you will experience the famous Beijing Duck banquet for your farewell dinner.

25 May Beijing/ Guangzhou/Departure(B/L)

Last minute free shopping at Silk Street before transfer to airport for flight to Auckland via Guangzhou CZ305(00:30+1--16:00+1).

26 May Auckland

Arrive in Auckland and go back your sweet home.
